PreventX 24/7 contains EPA 83129-1 a registered bacteriostatic with allowable (on-going) antimicrobial claims on label for **protecting surfaces** from bacteria, mold, mildew, and algae. A disinfectants' EPA approved label will list many specific organisms that it has been tested against to **protect the public**.

PreventX 24/7 will not be on any CDC list for COVID – 19 because it is *not a disinfectant*. Furthermore, it makes no claim for public protection only that of surfaces.

PreventX 24/7s' label is generic and by law is required not to list specific organisms. As a result, over the last 25 years, customers have asked for independent lab testing on various organisms for proofing. These include gram positive and negative bacteria along with enveloped and non-enveloped viruses.

Our position is that everyone should continue abiding with CDC recommendations and disinfecting protocols. PreventX 24/7 should never play a part in replacing disinfecting. However, if you want to take a crucial step to protect surfaces in-between disinfecting then we have a cost-effective and safe solution. Question is "What are you doing in-between disinfecting to protect your surfaces"?

We understand professionals are often unfamiliar with bacteriostatic claims and apologize for any unintended perceptions. However, we can claim over 25 years of success protecting surfaces and we do stand by all our independent testing.

To be clear, the choice is not whether to use PreventX 24/7 as part of a disinfecting protocol. The choice is to spend a few extra pennies a month (per square foot) to provide added antimicrobial protection to all your surfaces and touch points so that your surfaces are protected in between cleanings.
